Reasons for withdrawal	As part of the review cycle in line with Ofqual requirements, we are currently reviewing our playwork qualifications to ensure they are updated and reflect the new national occupational standards changes, legislation and terminology.
	Direct new replacement qualifications are being developed by NCFE alongside vocational subject specialists, and our virtual stakeholder panel comprised of our centres. Therefore, these qualifications will be unique to NCFE. The new qualifications will be launched on 01 July 2022, with updates being published in future horizon issues.
	The new qualifications are intended to be available in England, Wales and Northern Ireland.
	The current Level 2 Diploma in Playwork (NVQ) and the Level 3 Diploma in Playwork (NVQ) qualifications are also withdrawing from the Welsh apprenticeship framework. We are in discussions with Qualification Wales to gain inclusion of our new qualifications within the framework and will provide further updates in future horizon issues.
