NCFE CACHE Level 3 Certificate in Understanding the Care and Management of Diabetes (603/1609/3)

The qualification's content, structure and outcomes

This qualification is designed to increase your awareness and understanding of diabetes.

By completing the qualification, you will develop in-depth knowledge of diabetes which could support progression onto appropriate qualifications and into relevant employment in the health and social care sector.

The qualification will help you to understand:

- the types, causes, signs and symptoms of diabetes
- anatomy and physiology
- the consequences of diabetes on society, the individual and others
- the impact of diabetes on individuals, others and society
- the treatment and management of diabetes
- · common complications of diabetes.

To achieve this qualification, you'll need to complete 4 mandatory units:

- Unit 01 Understand diabetes
- Unit 02 Diabetes in context
- Unit 03 Understand the treatment and management of diabetes
- Unit 04 Understand the complications of diabetes

Similar qualifications

This is the only level 3 knowledge-based qualification offered by NCFE CACHE in this area and it supports progression from level 2 diabetes qualifications.
