Administering the External Assessment

The external assessment is invigilated and must be conducted in line with our <u>Regulations for the Conduct of External Assessment</u>. Learners may require additional pre-release material in order to complete the tasks within the paper. These must be provided to learners in line with our Regulations.

Learners must be given the resources to carry out the tasks and these are highlighted within the Qualification Specific Instructions Document (QSID).

Standard of learner work

Assessment Structure

• Learners submitted signposted scripts, identifying the criteria they were attempting

Use of word allocation

- All learners submitted exceptionally low word counts
- Only attempting the criteria they achieved

Criteria requirements and command verbs

Learners attempted lower grades only

Referencing of external assessment tasks

- Most referencing was appropriate with very few citations
- Some learners used large quotes which amounted to more than the original work submitted
