If we use external clinical staff to mark, will they need any training from NCFE?

There is no requirement for external clinical staff to attend NCFE training prior to marking. However, you (the provider) should attend the <u>prepare to assess training</u> to support you to run your own standardisation sessions. Any staff involved in making assessment decisions must be occupational competent as per the qualification specification and all staff involved in marking must be standardised.

Professional judgement should be used to determine the student's most appropriate band. Marks are checked through the standardisation and moderation processes. Marks can be adjusted through that process if required.
