	This qualification is suitable for apprentices aged 16 who are working as an apprentice dental nurse and who wish to complete an apprenticeship, register with the General Dental Council (GDC) and qualify as a dental nurse.
	This qualification is approved by the GDC and covers all of the GDC learning outcomes. Upon completion, it will enable learners to apply for registration with the GDC.
	This qualification is the mandatory element within the Apprenticeship Standard for Dental Nurses (England) (ST0113) and the end-point assessment is integrated into this qualification. Apprentices may register onto the apprenticeship bundle using code APP8309.
	This new qualification will replace NCFE CACHE Level 3 Diploma in the Principles and Practice of Dental Nursing (Integrated Apprenticeship) (603/6671/0) which withdrew on the 30 September 2022. The key change within the new version of the qualification is the overall grading which will be achieved/not yet achieved in line with the apprenticeship outcome which will be pass/fail for an apprentice registering on or after 6 July 2022. Apprentices registered on or before 5 July 2022 can continue to use 603/6671/0.
