Qualification structure

To be awarded the Level 1 Award in Relationships, Sex and Health Education learners are required to successfully complete Unit 1 and Unit 2

To be awarded the Level 2 Award in Relationships, Sex and Health Education learners are required to successfully complete Unit 3, Unit 4 and Unit 5.

To be awarded the Level 2 Certificate in Relationships, Sex and Health Education learners are required to successfully complete Unit 01, Unit 02, Unit 03, Unit 04 and Unit 05. To achieve this qualification, learners must successfully demonstrate their achievement of all learning outcomes of the units as detailed in the Qualification Specification.

A partial certificate may be requested for learners who do not achieve their full qualification but have achieved at least one whole unit.
