Qualification content, structure and outcomes

This qualification aims to increase your knowledge of dementia. The qualification will help you to understand:

- types of dementia and the importance of early diagnosis
- person-centered approaches in dementia care
- the role of communication, interaction and inclusion in dementia care and support
- the use of medication to support individuals with dementia.

To achieve this qualification, you'll need to complete 7 mandatory units:

- Unit 01 Understanding dementia
- Unit 02 Understand how person-centered approaches are used to underpin the care and support of individuals with dementia
- Unit 03 Principles of communication and interaction in dementia care and support
- Unit 04 Supporting positive interaction, occupation and activity in dementia care
- Unit 05 Principles of equality, diversity and inclusion in dementia care and support
- Unit 06 Understand how to support individuals with dementia to exercise choice and rights
- Unit 07 Principles of the administration of medication and well-being of individuals with dementia

There are no optional units.

Similar qualifications

This is the only knowledge based Level 3 Certificate in Understanding the Principles of Dementia Care offered by us and it supports progression from Level 2 Dementia qualifications. Alternatively, you could undertake the Level 3 Diploma in Health and Social Care (Adults) England dementia pathway. The Level 3 Diploma is a competence based qualification so you will need to be in employment.
