The investigation task you undertake will support you to carry out the supervised planning task.

Access to resources is permitted for the investigation task including books, magazines, journals and the internet (for more information, see 'investigation task' below).

For the planning task, you will be provided with a teacher's lesson plan, additional information about the planned lesson and the needs of individual pupils.

You may bring in two sides of notes on one piece of A4 paper, based on the investigation task you have carried out. Access to other resources is **not** permitted for the planning task.

Investigation task

As a teaching assistant, you are required to support the class teacher and the pupils' individual learning and pastoral needs. In order to do this, you will need to consider your role alongside that of the teacher.

You must carry out an investigation using a range of sources of information to enable you to support differentiation and progress within a **key stage 3 English lesson**. The focus of the lesson is **imaginative writing**.

You will need to:

- research the national curriculum and expected progression for key stage 3 English

You will need to show how you would:

- support differentiation and progress for higher or lower achieving pupils in the lesson

You have **one** week to carry out your investigation.
