Our V Certs are vocational equivalents to GCSEs and count towards the Open Group of your Progress 8 measures. Designed in collaboration with employers and practitioners, they empower your pupils with industry-relevant skills and knowledge appropriate to a range of growing sectors, giving them a taste of what it's like to complete real-world tasks and projects.

V Certs are designed to fit seamlessly into your KS4 curriculum. We assess pupils using project-based non-exam assessments, as well as external examinations, to give them the opportunity to achieve based on their skills as well as their knowledge.

We're here to support you every step of the way and provide a range of tools to help you get off to a flying start:

Subject areas

All of our V Certs are combined Level 1/Level 2, to recognise the achievements of pupils of all abilities. This means that they're graded from Level 1 Pass, Merit, Distinction, through to Level 2 Pass, Merit, Distinction, Distinction*, which is the equivalent to GCSE grades 1-8.5.

Level 1/2 Technical Award in Health and Fitness

Our Health and Fitness V Cert provides core knowledge to pupils who are passionate about fitness and performance – from the structure and function of body systems and the effects of health and fitness activities on the body, through to the principles of training and how to structure a health and fitness programme.

What's next?

- Further study: an A Level in Physical Education and Sport or an Applied General in Sport at college or sixth form
- Apprenticeship: as a personal trainer or community sport and health officer.

Level 1/2 Technical Award in Sports Studies

Focusing on a range of important and topical content areas – including ethics and technology in sport to psychology for sports performance – this V Cert can help pupils on their way to a career in sports coaching, sports management, and physiotherapy.

What's next?

- Further study: an A Level in Physical Education and Sport, or a Level 3 study programme in sports coaching at college or sixth form
- Apprenticeship: as a sporting excellence professional or outdoor activity instructor.

Level 1/2 Technical Award in Health and Social Care (CACHE)

Our CACHE health and social care qualifications are the hallmark of quality, as market leaders in this area. This qualification prepares pupils to enter the health and social care sector with the knowledge, skills and behaviours to succeed. They'll learn about the many rewarding job roles available across the sector, the care values that underpin professional practice, and the legislation and procedures in health and social care.

What's next?

- → Further study: a T Level in Health or Healthcare Science, or Applied Generals or Level 3 study programmes in health and social care at college or sixth form
- → Apprenticeship: as an adult carer or youth support worker.



Level 1/2 Technical Award in Child Development and Care in the Early Years (CACHE)

This qualification will help pupils learn about the effects of biological and environmental factors on the growth of a child, the importance of play and activities in a child's healthy development, and understand the ways to make a positive impact in this field.

What's next?

- Further study: a T Level in Education and Childcare or Applied General at college or sixth form
- → Apprenticeship: as an early years educator or teaching assistant.

Level 1/2 Technical Award in Business and Enterprise

Studying this V Cert will give pupils the core skills and knowledge they'll need to prepare for an enterprising career. They'll learn how a business is structured, who stakeholders are and why they're important, and will gain an understanding of the different areas of a business, from HR and finance to operations and marketing.

What's next?

- → Further study: a T Level in Management and Administration, or a Business A Level or Applied General at college or sixth form
- → Apprenticeship: in business administration or as a marketing assistant.

Level 1/2 Technical Award in Engineering

By studying the engineering process from end to end, pupils will learn core skills such as production planning techniques, Computer-Aided Design (CAD) drawings, and applied processing skills and techniques, helping to begin their journey into further study or a career in engineering.

What's next?

- Further study: a T Level in Engineering, Manufacturing, Processing and Control, or an A Level or Applied General in Engineering
- → Apprenticeship: in welding, lean manufacturing or as a metal fabricator.

Level 1/2 Technical Award in Food and Cookery

Studying our V Cert in Food and Cookery will give pupils the fundamental skills and knowledge they'll need to prepare for a career in the hospitality and catering sector. This qualification covers key subject areas, from food health and safety and information on key food groups and key nutrients, to recipe development, amendment and evaluation.

What's next?

- → Further study: a T Level in Catering, Level 3 Applied Certificate/Diploma in Food Science and Nutrition, or an Advanced Technical Diploma in Professional Cookery
- → Apprenticeship: as a production chef, commis chef or chef de partie.

Level 1/2 Technical Award in Creative Design and Production

From arts and crafts to postmodernism – our Creative Design and Production V Cert will allow pupils to explore the history of design, whilst learning the key principles of design, materials and production to enable them to bring their creations to life.

What's next?


- → Further study: a T Level in Craft and Design, A Level in Design and Technology, or an Applied General in Art and Design at college or sixth form
- > Apprenticeship: in jewellery design or furniture making.

Level 1/2 Technical Award in Interactive Media

This V Cert is an exciting first step for pupils interested in working in interactive media. Pupils will gain insight into all types of interactive media products, learning about their features and their audiences before delving into how to develop, promote and present an interactive media product.

What's next?

- Further study: a T Level in Media, Broadcast and Production or an A Level in Media Studies at college or sixth form
- Apprenticeship: as a junior content producer or broadcast production assistant.



Level 1/2 Technical Award in Graphic Design

From planning and development through to designing and presenting – this qualification will help creative pupils to understand the work and the processes of a graphic designer, whilst helping them to take their first steps into a career or further study in this sector.

What's next?

- → Further study: a Level 3 National Diploma or Extended Diploma in Art and Design Practice (Graphic Design), or an A Level in Graphic Design at college or sixth form
- → Apprenticeship: as a junior advertising creative.

Level 1/2 Technical Award in Music Technology

From sound creation, to the digital audio workstation (DAW), to multitrack recording – this V Cert will help pupils to learn many of the core skills and behaviours that they'll need to become adept and enter a career path within the field of music technology.

What's next?

- Further study: a T Level in Media, Broadcast and Production or an A Level in Music at college or sixth form
- Apprenticeship: as a live event rigger.
